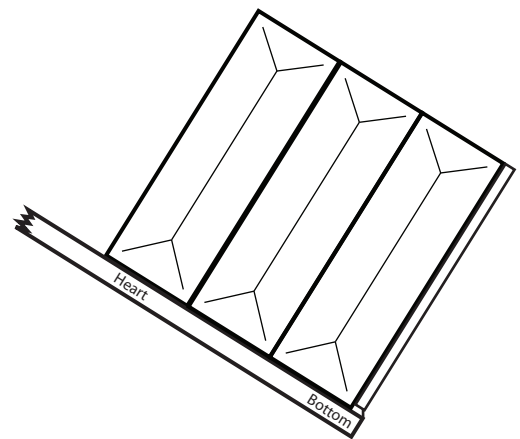
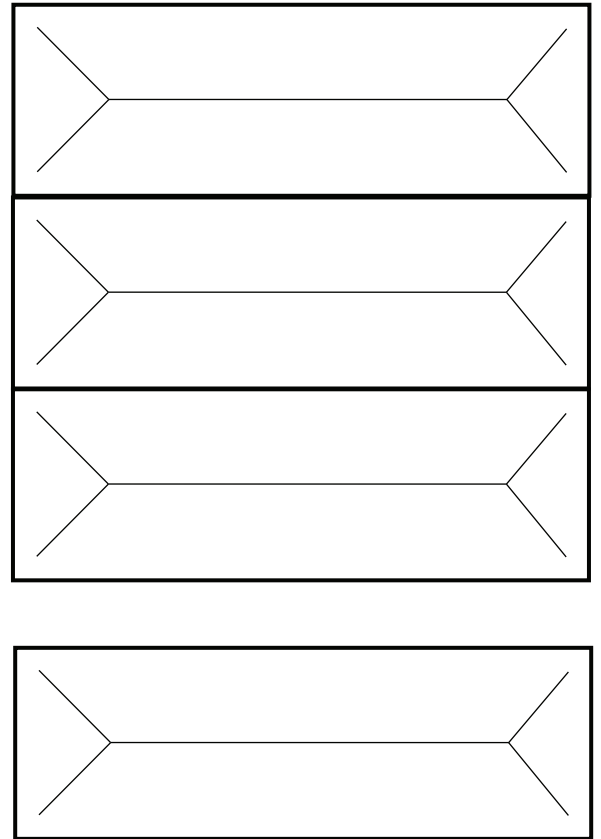
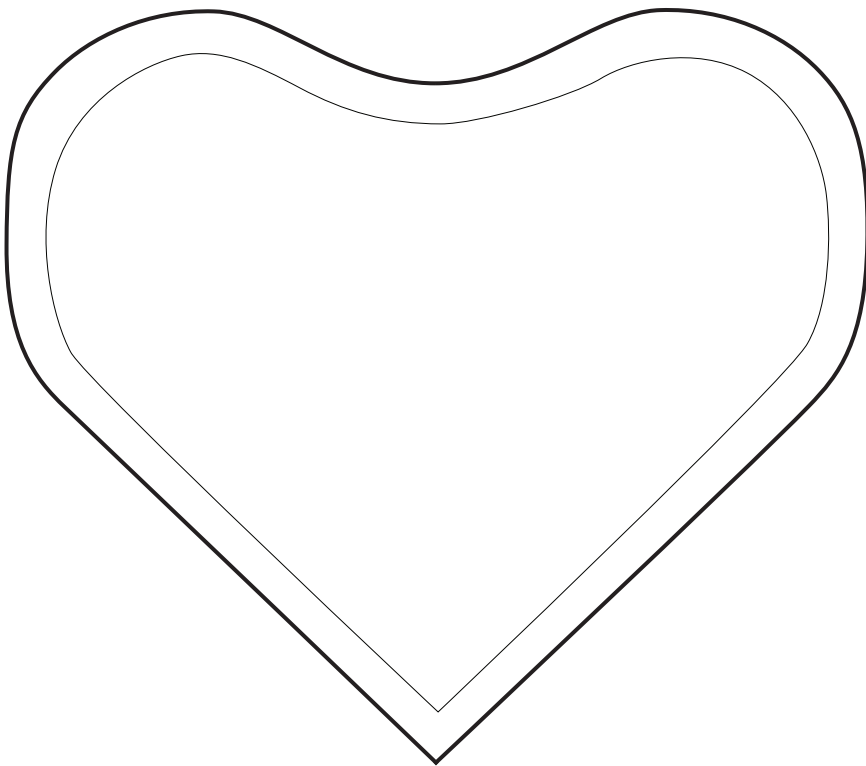

## Beveled Heart Potpourri Holder

*Glass*

- 2 — heart shaped bevels (approximately 4.5")
- 8 — 1" x 3" stock bevels or any combination of bevels or glass that you like
- 2 — hanging rings



Solder three 1" x 3" bevels together, front and back, to form a square for one side of the container. Make another square for the other side.

Place one heart, bevel side down, on your work surface. Set the edge of one side piece on top of the heart, as shown in the diagram, and tack solder the two together. Repeat with the other square to form the other side.

Place the last heart, bevel side up, on top of the sides and tack solder. Make any adjustments necessary to create a pleasing shape and run a solder bead on the inside and outside of the container.

Finally, place the last 1" x 3" bevel on each side, following the curve of the heart, to complete the potpourri holder. Again, solder the inside and outside of the container. Finish the top edge with a nice solder bead and attach two hanging rings on opposite corners.

You can replace the 1" x 3" bevels on each flat side with different bevels, stained glass, or fused glass.
